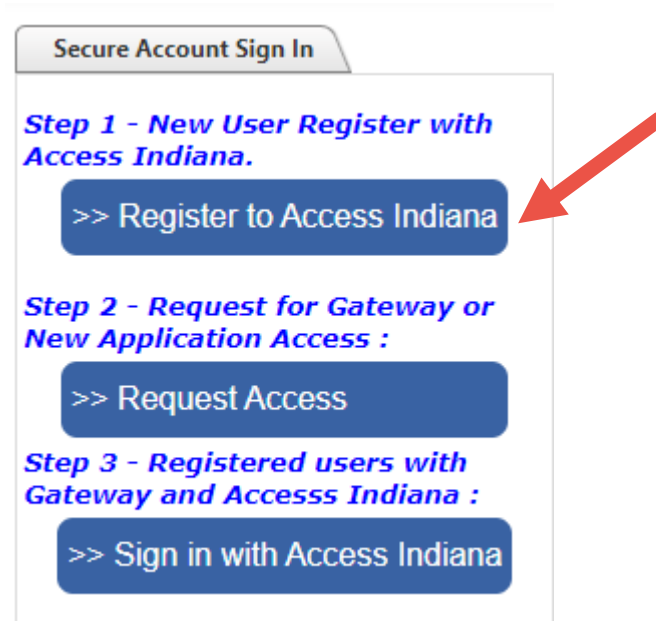
Go to the IDOH Gateway

1. The Gateway url remains the same at

<https://gateway.isdh.in.gov/Gateway/SignIn.aspx>, but it looks a bit different. Notice the new buttons on the right.

Users must register for Access Indiana

2. If you have not registered for Access Indiana, click on **Register for Access Indiana** so you can continue using the Gateway applications.

Registered Access Indiana Users

3. Once you've registered for Access Indiana, you may request Gateway access or access to specific Gateway applications by clicking on **Request Access**. (If you're already a registered Gateway user, go to the next slide.)



Now you're ready to sign in with Access Indiana

4. Users who are registered with Access Indiana will now log into Gateway by going through the Access Indiana link. Click on **Sign in with Access Indiana**. This will send you to the Access Indiana sign-in page.

Step 1 - New User Register with Access Indiana.

Step 2 - Request for Gateway or New Application Access :

>> Request Access


Step 3 - Registered users with Gateway and Access Indiana :

>> Sign in with Access Indiana

Click on **Sign in with Access Indiana**. Will redirect to the Access Indiana sign-in page.

5. Sign in through the Access Indiana sign-in page. Enter the email address you used to register for Access Indiana, which should match your Gateway email address. Click **Continue**.



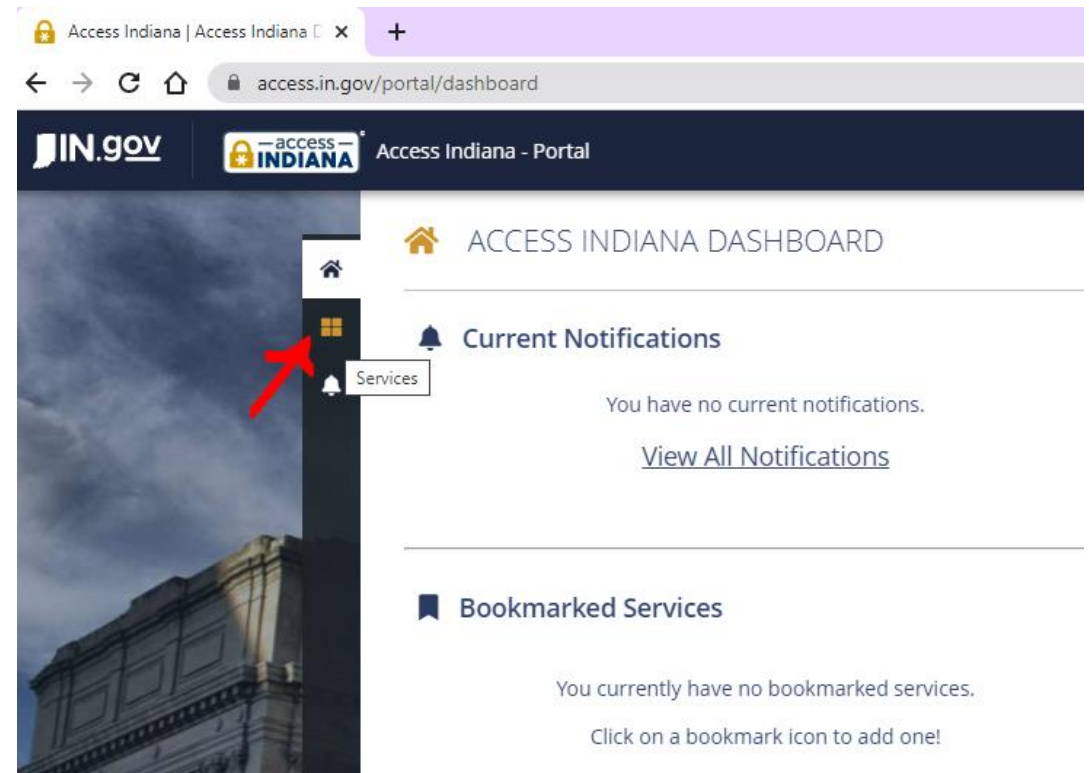

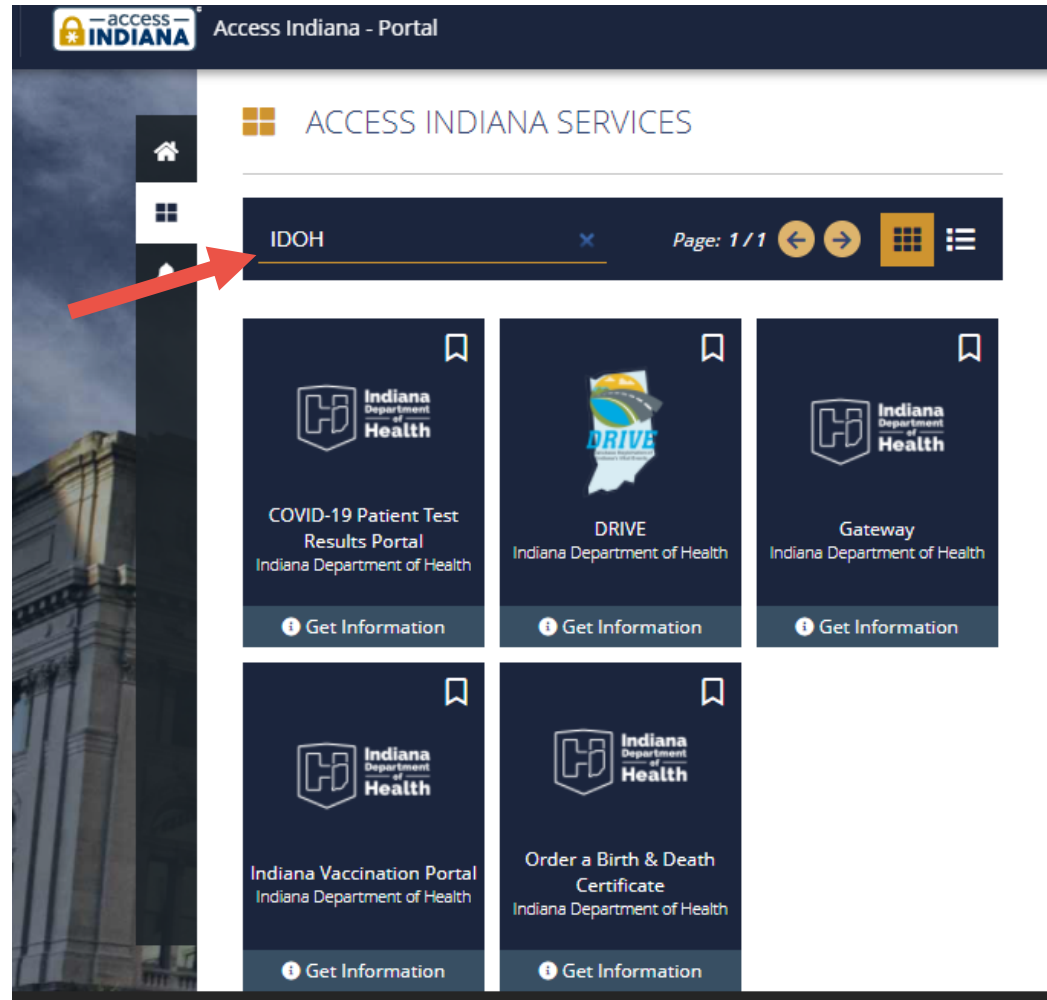
7. If you are not on the network or vpn, the first time you log in to Access Indiana you may need to find and bookmark the Gateway tile so it will be added to your Access Indiana dashboard.

Click on the four small squares in the menu on the left; this is the Services icon.





8. In the Search bar type in "IDOH" to display the various tiles related to IDOH. From here you can either click on the Gateway tile to go to the Gateway, or you can bookmark tiles to add to your Dashboard.

9. Bookmark any tiles you want to add to your Bookmarked services on your Dashboard.
